

## Late Students

At West London Academy we take punctuality and attendance very seriously and new sanctions have been put into place for the minority of students who are constantly late to the Academy. To tackle this we are enforcing penalties to students who are constantly late - here are the stages of action that they will face:



- \* Stage one - 30 mins detention
- \* Stage two - 45 mins detention
- \* Stage three - Academy Detention
- \* Stage four - Part of lunchtime will be spent with the Academy Building Services Team doing Community service around the Academy.

A student's first late of the week will not incur a sanction but the student will have to discuss the matter with their SaFE Worker.

We recognise that a minimum of 24 hours notice has to be given to parents with regards to detentions and written notice will be given. Parents/carers who cannot be contacted in writing will be notified with a phone call from a SaFE Worker.

We hope that these new sanctions will deter students from being late to school, and with the full support of parents and guardians we are sure to resolve this situation to ensure that students are at the Academy making the most of the opportunities to learn.

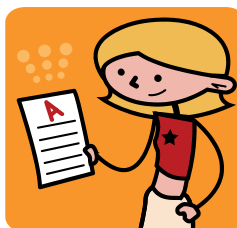
