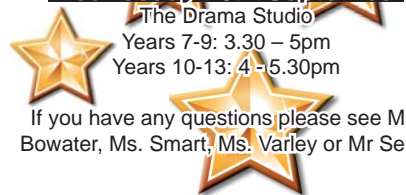

Wednesday 26th September 3:30 - 4:30 p.m.

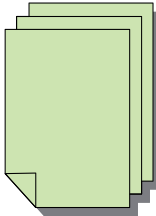

\* Absences – please make sure that you call the office on the first day of your child's absence.

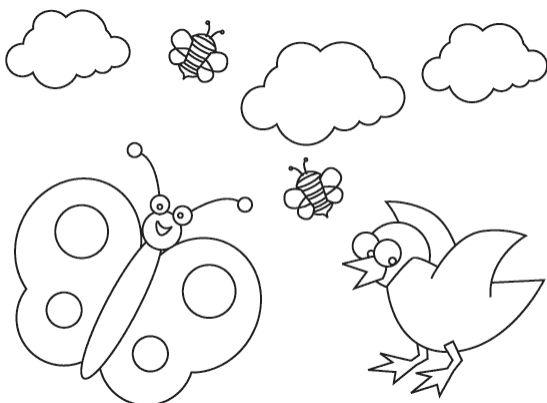
\* Lunch Money – Please remember to pay for your school lunch on a Monday in advance. £8.75 per week.
