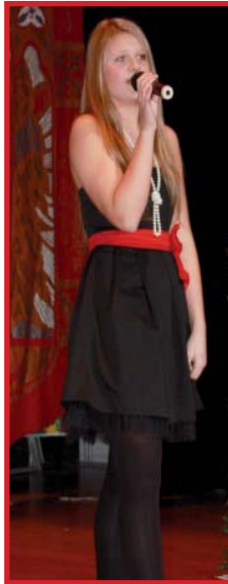

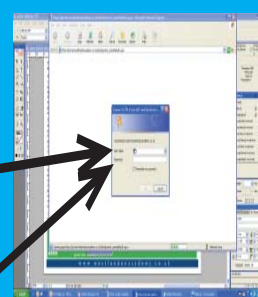
Football Boots - Can students please bring in football boots for PE lessons so that they can have lessons on the grass, especially rugby
