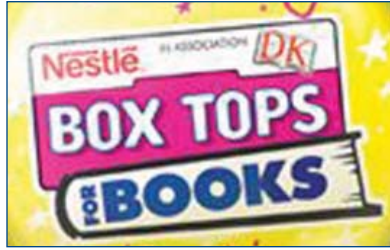
Inter House Fundraising Week
