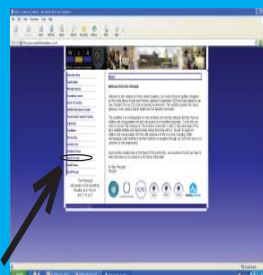

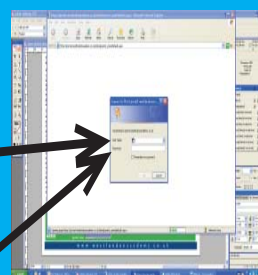

By meeting and talking to senior leaders, campaigners and decision makers, and by taking part in role plays, simulations and discussions, the

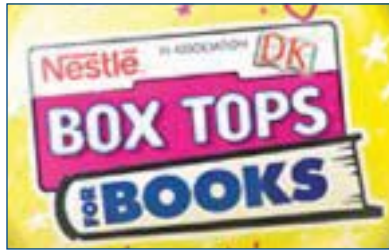
participants discover how to lead more effectively, how to work in a team and resolve problems through negotiation.
